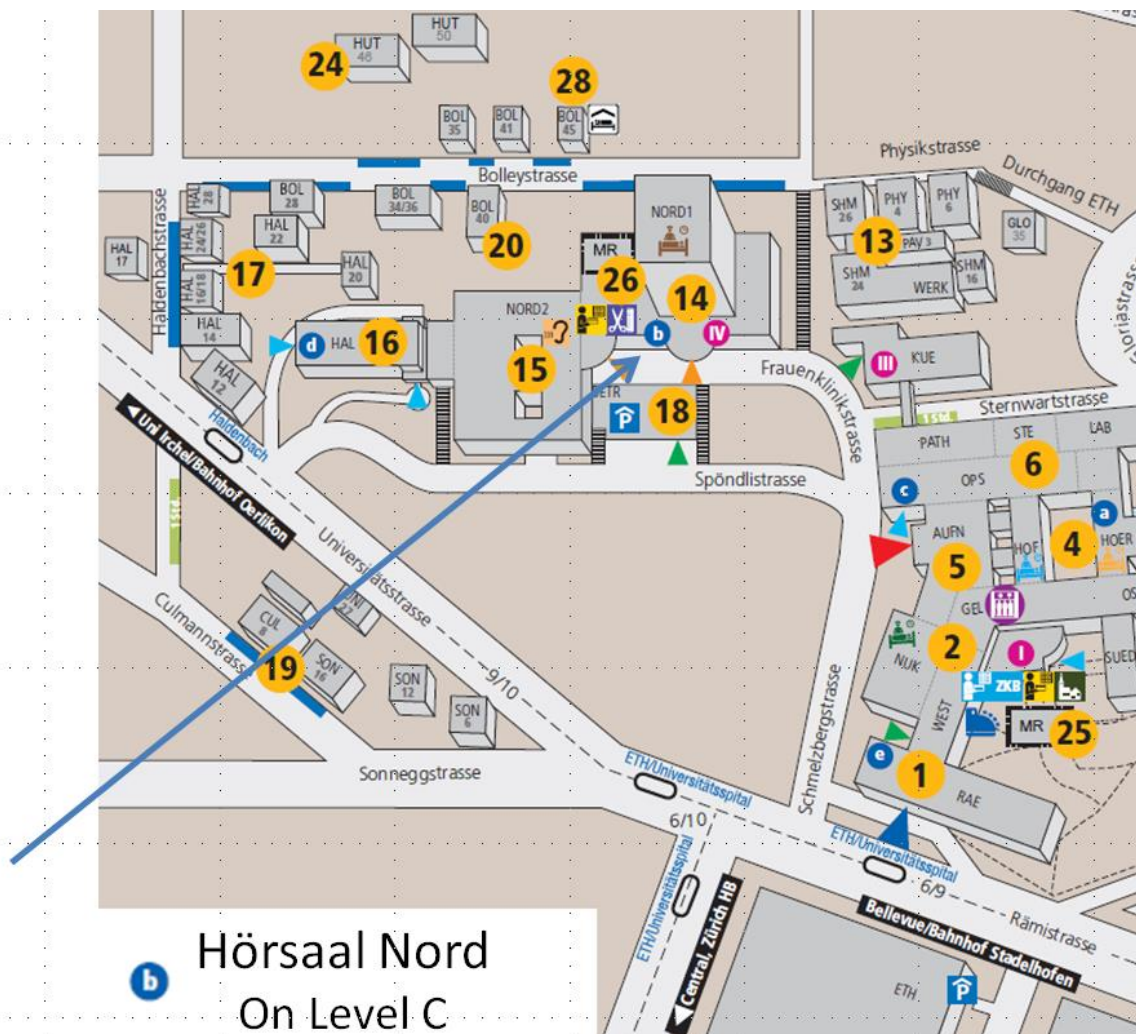
Venue

Autumn Meeting 2015

The Autumn Meeting will take place at the **Universitätsspital Zürich (USZ), Hörsaal Nord on level "C"**, accessible via Frauenklinikstrasse (Building Number 14; Frauenklinik, see figure).

Using the tram, the meeting place is 6 minutes away from the central train station and can be reached by tram lines nr. 6 (Direction Zürich Zoo) and nr. 10 (Direction Zürich Flughafen). The stop is called "ETH/Universitätsspital". Proceed walking Schmelzbergstrasse past the Emergency (Notfall Eingang), enter Frauenklinikstrasse and the Building will be on your right hand side.

Coming from the ESLHO Symposium at the World Trade Center (Messe), take tram nr. 10 direction Zürich Flughafen/Bhf directly to stop ETH/Universitätsspital (ca. 30min).
